Overview of the LEAPS Domains in the Co-Curriculum

LEAPS 2.0 DOMAINS

- To recognise students' holistic development
- 4 domains has levels of attainment: 1 – 5
- Development in 4 domains - Count towards **bonus points** for admission to post-secondary
- **Enrichment** domain **complements** the other domains for students' holistic development and will be recognised in **School Graduation Certificate**.

Key Information on LEAPS 2.0

Participation

- Affirms students' sustained development in school-based CCA throughout secondary school
- Same CCA - progressive development
 - higher recognition



CCA
Attendance

Achievement

- Affirms students' character development and efforts in representing the school/external organisations in events
- Opportunity for representation
 - Valuable learning experiences
 - Discipline, resilience & develop character



Competitions

Key Information on LEAPS 2.0

Leadership

- Affirms students' development as a leader
- Students are developed through leadership modules e.g. National Youth Achievement Award and class/CCA/school leadership roles.



Service

- Affirms students' contributions to the community and development as responsible and active citizens
- Students serve the community through school's Values-In-Action and Environmental Education programmes.



CCA Policy Guidelines

- **Compulsory** for every student to participate in at least **one** school-based CCA.
- Students may request for a **2nd CCA** through HOD/PE&CCA and SH/PE&CCA only at the end of Sec 1 and when they have shown that they are able to cope well with both studies and CCA.
- Participation in outside activities in lieu of school CCAs will be considered on a **case-by-case basis**. Points will be awarded only if the activities are approved by the school.

CCA Policy Guidelines

Change of CCA

Students can request for a change under the following conditions:

- on **medical reasons** or
- only **once at the end** of Secondary 1 or 2 with good reasons and justification.

Special Guidelines

Please note that there are **special guidelines** for BAND, NPCC & NCDCC (Mandatory CCAs)

Students in the Concert Band, National Police Cadet Corps (NPCC) and National Civil Defence (NCDCC) are **encouraged to stay** in their CCA and any request for change is based on a **case-by-case basis**.

Sec 1 CCA Bidding Exercise

The CCA bidding systems aims to:

- Allow all students to take **ownership** of their own CCA choices
- Allow all students to put **careful considerations** and strategize before submitting their bids
- Increase the likelihood of students getting the CCAs that they prefer, provided all allocation guidelines have been met
- CCA allocation system is fair, effective and transparent
- Every year, we have a **high percentage** of students getting their top 4 choices.
- *Exceptions - students who failed to meet the deadline, placed their bids wrongly or did not follow the instructions.*

Bidding Example 1

$$1^{\text{st}} \text{ Bid} + 2^{\text{nd}} \text{ Bid} + 3^{\text{rd}} \text{ Bid} + 4^{\text{th}} \text{ Bid} = 100$$

1st Bid : Art & Crafts

97 points

2nd Bid : Netball

1 point

3rd Bid : NPCC

1 point

4th Bid: Scouts

1 point

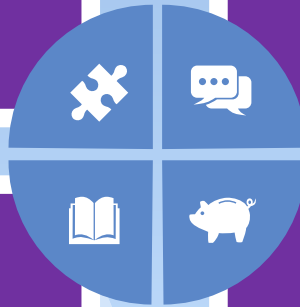

Important Points to Note

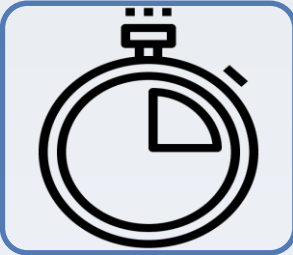
- Importance of CCA bidding exercise
- Time stamp of CCA bids is not important
- Estimated number of CCA vacancies as been made known to the students
- There will be a **5th compulsory CCA choice** of: Concert Band, NPCC, NCDCC or Scouts where the student may be allocated this CCA if he/she is not given either one of his/her 4 choices.
- Sec 1 students will **attend the allocated CCA till end of Term 1 (trial period)**. A request for change will be considered on a case-by-case basis with valid reasons.

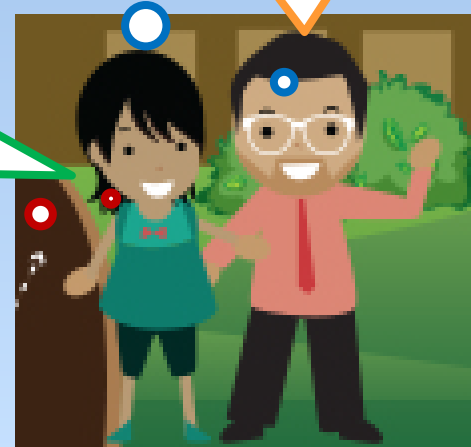
